

**MINUTES OF THE DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE (DDC) MEETING HELD ON
05/02/2018, AT THE CONFERENCE HALL OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONER, DHEMAJI**

Members present: - As per **Annexure-I**.

The DDC meeting was presided over by Shri Naba Kr. Deka Boruah, ACS, District Development Commissioner Dhemaji. Welcoming all the members present, the meeting started by reviewing last DDC meeting minutes by the Chair.

1. **AGRICULTURE**: - Participating in the discussion the DAO informed the house that 342 nos. of applications sent to the concerned Bank branches to accord the loan sanctioned for Tractors to SHGs under CMSUY. As reported by the DAO, that due to some differences between subsidy and bank loan, the process has been temporally stopped. He also informed the house that a Nodal officer has been appointed to take initiative with the Bank branches for the same.

The DAO also informed the house that the distribution of Rabi seed to the beneficiaries is completed. The DDC directed him to submit beneficiaries list in details.
(Action: DAO, Dhemaji).

2. **DEEO**: - The representative of DEEO informed the house that Gunotsav Phase III is successfully completed in the district. DDC requested the DPO to submit utilization certificate against the SUHRID scheme beneficiary of education related schemes provided as grants in aid under MLALADS fund within 10 days (Action : Inspector of schools and DPO Dhemaji)

3. **APDCL**: - The Asstt. General Manager ,APDCL Dhemaji informed the house that 16 MW power transformer is yet to be brought from Biswanath Charali power station which is to be installed at Hatigarh, Dhemaji to enhance power position in the Dhemaji. He also informed the house that bamboo posts of the consumers have been replaced in phased manner and the work is in progress. The DDC directed him to submit report on LED light in detail. Further DDC Requested AGM Silapather to submit list of unelectrified villages and solar light of Jonai Sub-Division and urged him to arrange a discussion with the SDO (C) Jonai in this regard. AGM Dhemaji & Silapather informed the house that the LED bulb distribution has been completed in the district and distribution of some nos. of fans are yet to be completed. **DDC urged both the AGM to indent for additional requirements of LED bulb for the district at the earliest. (Action: Asst. General Manager Dhemaji & Silapather APDCL).**

4. **FISHERY**: - The DFDO informed the house that seventy percent work completed on hector community tank at Nahar Bondona, Jonai .Further he also informed the house that beel fishery project at Singejan Na-nadi is taken under MGNREGA. The land has not yet been handed over to him to provide technical support to execute the work.

The DEEO informed the house that Beel Fishery project at Changmai Dolony at Samarajan G.P not started because of land dispute.

5. **PWD State (R)**: - The Ex.Engineer PWD (R) Roads apprised that construction of road from Gohain Chapori to Khalihamari has started and extended upto 3 Kms. The Dy. CEO, Zilla Parishad apprised the house that construction of road of Chenai chuk is taken under MGNREGA and Rs. 3,00,000.00 (Rupees Three Lakhs)only is utilized for the same . Further he informed the house that said road is taken under PMGSY. In this regard Dy. CEO, Zila Parishad informed the house that there is a Balance of amount Rs 12,000,00.00 and construction of remaining road length will be taken up under PMGSY. Participating in the discussion DDC Dhemaji directed the concerned Departments to carry out physical inspection of road as communicated earlier and submit report accordingly. Further DDC

directed the Ex. Engineer PWD (State) Roads to prepare road map of Katcha, Pacca Graveled Blacktopping etc. to be incorporate in it.

6. PWD (NH): The SDO (C) Jonai appraised the house that numbers of unscientific speed breaker have installed in Jonai area over national highways, which may cause severe road accidents. In this context DDC Dhemaji citing the reference of Indian Road Congress Norms (Section IRC 99-1988) where clearly stated as “Speed breakers should be painted with alternative black and white bands to give additional visual warning. For better night visibility, it is desirable that the markings are in luminous paints/luminous strips. Embedded cat eyes can also be used to enhance night visibility.” (Action: PWD NH).

7. T &CP: - The Deputy Director T&CP Dhemaji informed the house that he has submitted the DPR of Dhemaji Town Committee under BLC component of PMAY for phase II to Mission Director Guwahati, and after the approval the work will be start.

8. DTO: - The DTO Dhemaji informed the house that revenue collection is 75. 29 lakhs during Jan’2018 and cumulative achievement is 5. 79 corers for the year 2017-18 with achievement percentage of 86.67. (Total target of revenue collection for the year 2017-18 is 6.69 corers.) He also informed the house that revenue collection is affected due to vacancy of Enforcement Inspector since long back, and informed the house that they will fulfill the revenue collection within the financial year.

9. SERICULTURE :-Participating in the discussion the DDC directed the Suptd. of Sericulture to give more emphasis on development of Muga plantation in Dhemaji. DDC directed Suptd. Of Sericulture to give technical support to Muga rearer for expansion of Muga cultivation .

10. DI&CC:-The General Manager (DI&CC) informed the house that he submitted 4 nos. of beneficiaries under new plantation to be covered by small tea growers and submitted 2 nos. of beneficiaries under CEGS Utilization Amended’2015 to the Director, Tea Board of Assam. The GM DI&CC informed the house that he had arranged a meeting with the Small Tea growers and Muga cultivators and requesting the Small tea growers to go for biological instead of chemical pesticides. **While participating in the discussion DDC requesting the DI&CC official to make necessary arrangements for at least three nos. of factory at Jonai , Gugamukh and Machkhowa area for the small tea growers of the district.**

11. AGRICULTURE ENGINEERING: - The Ex-Engineer, Agriculture informed the house that fund sanctioned for 2 nos. of projects for water harvesting tanks at Bengenagarah and Bhebeli under TSP for Rabi Cultivation. **Participating in the discussion DDC, Dhemaji highlighted the nature of soil structure in the district and requested him to go for Israel technology system etc. for better implementation of the scheme. (Action: Ex. Engineer, Agriculture)**

12. WATER RESOURCE DEPARTMENT: The Ex-Engineer informed the house that 5 nos. of schemes have been approved and work will be started from last part of February 2018. He informed the house that the work will be started at left bank of Kumotia River, Nanodi and upper Gai nodi area. The tender process is already completed for these schemes, he informed.

13. Miscellaneous:

The Honorable I/C Deputy Commissioner Sri Utpal Borah, ACS informed the house that District Legal service camp will be held at Dibru Mising H.S School on

11/02/2018. He urged all concerned Department Heads to give their full cooperation for successful completion of the camp.

And last DDC Dhemaji, urged all the HOD of the district to be present in all the DDC meetings positively.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks form the chair.
